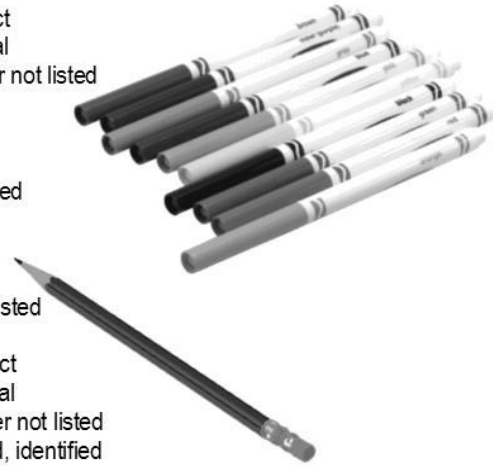

CLASS E — MUSIC, DRAMA & DANCE

- ◆ All accompaniment, instruments, equipment must be provided by the exhibitor. Accompaniment may be on tape/CD
- ◆ All performers must provide a performance copy for the Judge. Photocopy and editing are acceptable.
- ◆ Duet/Group Performances, where there are two different age groups, will be judged in the oldest age group
- ◆ Exhibitors may perform pieces of their choice that have not previously been performed at the Florence County Fair
- ◆ Lip-syncing is not allowed
- ◆ Performances should be age appropriate
- ◆ Performances will be judged on Thursday, August 22 during exhibit judging. Exhibitors are encouraged to perform during the fair itself as well. Contact the fair office to schedule a performance time.
- ◆ Time limit: Grades 3-5 no less than 1 minute or more than 4 minutes; Grades 6 and up: no less than 2 minutes or more than 7 minutes; Group Performances no less than 2 minutes or more than 10 minutes

DEPARTMENT 20: PHOTOGRAPHY

- ◆ Definition of a portrait is a fine photograph of a person's face or the person's entire figure
- ◆ Definition of a still life photo is a collection of objects "not living" arranged by the photographer
- ◆ Exhibitors can only enter in their experience group and only one exhibit per lot.
- ◆ Exhibits with more than one photo must have the pictures mounted together for one exhibit & for display purposes
- ◆ Photo print quality may affect the placing of the ribbon
- ◆ Photo sets may be cropped no smaller than 3"x3" and no larger than 4"x6"—unless otherwise stated
- ◆ Photos may be black/white or color, except where specified
- ◆ Photos may only be entered once. The same photo cannot be used in a collection and an enlargement.
