The Barnesville Community Education provides two theater opportunities for students in Barnesville. We offer a spring play for seventh to 12th graders and a summer play for Kindergarten to 10th graders. Both of these productions take place in the small gym at the Barnesville High School in what has been known to be called the cafegymatorium (old gym). One thing that is a benefit for Community Education is our talented director, Alissa Nibbe. She puts so much time and energy into every show. She seems to have a knack at getting the most out of her thespians.

The shows that Barnesville Community Education has in store for family's this spring and summer include Sally Cotter and the Prisoner of Ala Katraz by Dean O'Carroll and

Disney's Aladdin Kids'.

Tryouts for the spring show took place at the beginning of March and the students are busy putting together this great production. The show will be on stage on Friday, May 3 and Saturday May 4, at 7:30 p.m. and again on Sunday, May 5, at 2:00 p.m. in the high school gym.

The spring play is a parody based on the Harry Potter series. Sally Cotter is the main character and she is dreaming that she is a student at the bewitching Frogbull Academy of Sorcery. She is caught up in teenage drama as well as dealing with mysterious escaped convict Taurus Ford and battling her rival, Ursa Malaise, in the Gauntlet of Ire. Will she triumph at the expense of helping her best friends, Dave and Harmonica,

with their issues all while evading Murderdeath and his terrifying Demeanors? Mark your calendars for May 3, 4 and 5 to come and see the high school production of Sally Cotter and the Prisoner of Ala Katraz by Dean O'Carroll.

Every summer we have a week long theater program for students that will be completing Kindergarten through 10th grade. We will have tryouts sometime the week of May 20 for students. This will give the kids a chance to take their scripts home and learn some of their parts before rehearsals start on May 28.

The summer play is going to be Disney's Aladdin Kids presented through special arrangement with Music Theatre International (MTI).

All authorized performance materials are also supplied by MTI. Music by Alan Menken,

Lyrics by Howard Ashman and Tim Rice. Book by David Simpatico and based on the

1992 Disney film Aladdin.

The synopsis of the play is A Lamp Vendor appears in a marketplace conjured by Djinn, theatrical "sprites of the lamp." A group of Agrabahns help him introduce the city of Agrabah and the story of a dusty old lamp that changed a young man's life. This production will include great songs and acting by local talented kids. We generally have over 50 students that take part in the production. We also have in addition to Alissa Nibbe, two to four students that help with the production of the show. This is a great way for the young students to learn how to put on a play, become someone different for the production, find out about costumes, etc. It is also great for the student director/helpers to learn what goes into putting a play on working with young kids.

We will be having the production of Disney's Aladdin Kids on Friday, May 31, at 7:00 p.m. and again on Saturday, June 1, at 10:00 a.m.
