Visitation was held on Monday, July 1, 2019 from 4:00-6:00 p.m. at the funeral home and one hour prior at the church.

Interment is in Bethlehem Cemetery in Fergus Falls.

Doris Ann Kathryn Hauger was born on February 15, 1925, in Parkers Prairie, Minnesota the daughter of Henry and Marie (Hink) Kalpin. She attended the Parkers Priaire Public School through the 10th grade where she was a drummer with the marching band.

Doris married Gordon Millard Hauger on July 28, 1952, in the Zion Lutheran Church in Alexandria, Minnesota. They lived in different locations, then settled in Fergus Falls in 1970.

She was a homemaker who raised her children and kept them going through tough times, in particular when Gordon was seriously injured in a work accident. She had a playful sense of humor, and was a remarkably strong and faithful mother and caregiver to more than just her children. Through the years, she worked with Northwestern Bell Telephone as an operator, Osterbergs Café, Parkers Prairie Hospital and in dietary services with the Fergus Falls Public School.

She enjoyed watching birds at the feeder, cooking, dancing, designing homemade birthday cards, crafting, making stuffed animals, dolls, and clothes for the grandkids, dressing up for Halloween, singing "Happy Birthday" in funny voices, and in her retirement she took karate lessons.

Doris was a member of Destiny Church of rural Ashby and at the age of 64 she accepted Jesus as her Saviour and was born again then at the Country Bible Church. Doris guided her ship and her crew through calm waters and stormy seas, and is now safely at harbor.
