paction (such as radishes and/or cereal rye)  
 —establish Monarch butterfly habitat  
 —conservation cover to provide food habitat for pollinators and beneficial insects, and  
 —no-till to increase soil health and organic matter content.  
 Conservation practices such as conserva-

tion cover for wildlife, nutrient management, and planting cover crops are also common CStP practices.

processing cost is not included in the package. (Approximately 150 pounds).

The finished bundles must be picked up at the Carthage locker by the buyers.

WIU junior Paige Skinner, an agriculture science major from Roseville, said she has learned new skills through the Leatherneck Country Meats project.

“There is no change in the production side because of the new business,” she said. “This is really just finding a new way to market the product.”

Humphrey said he believes the new program is an opportunity to get a glimpse of what students in the WIU School of Agriculture are working on.

“It makes me more conscious of understanding different ways of marketing,” he said. “This is also a way to add value to our product.”

The business will offer meat for sale once each year, typically in the winter. The hope is that next year the meat can be shipped to buyers.
