
### Obituaries -----

## **SNAP Benefits will Continue Through February During** Federal Shutdown but will be Issued Earlier Than Usual

CHICAGO - The Illinois Department of Human Services (IDHS) announced today that February Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits will be funded through the end of February, but they will be issued to Illinois customers on or before January 20th. Typically, benefits are issued in the first few days of the month.

"We want to reassure our customers that SNAP benefits

are funded through the end of February," IDHS Secretary James Dimas said. "However, we need to spread the word as quickly and widely as possible that these benefits will be issued earlier than usual."

SNAP is a federal program administered by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) and distributed through IDHS in Illinois. January and February SNAP benefits will not be affected by the current lack

Because of the way the USDA has funded February SNAP benefits, they must be issued on or before January 20th. This is about a week and half earlier than usual for customers.

of federal appropriations.

There is no need for customers to visit the local IDHS offices or call their caseworkers. IDHS staff will be working in the upcoming days to implement the necessary changes so customers see no disruption in their benefits.
