and of knowing making physical contact of insulting or provoking nature with a family or household member on December 19. Charges were filed December 19.

Byron Duran, 20, of Uniondale, New York, has been charged with criminal damage to property, a Class A misdemeanor. Duran is accused of damaging a window at Monical's Pizza Restaurant in Arcola on December 28 with value of the damage being less than \$500. Charge was filed January 9.

Cody C. Allen, 21, of Tuscola has been charged with domestic battery, unlawful violation of an order of protection, and unlawful interference with the reporting of domestic violence, Class A misdemeanors. Allen is accused of causing bodily harm to a family or household member on January 1 by hitting the person, causing bruising and redness; of intentionally committing an act on January 1 that was prohibited by an order of protection in that Allen made physical contact with the protected person while being in the same residence as the person; and of taking a cell phone away from a victim of domestic violence on January 1 in an attempt to prevent that person from using the phone to report that an act of domestic violence had been committed upon the person by Allen. Charges were filed January 2.

Stephine N. Byers, 34, of Villa Grove has been charged with two counts of domestic battery, Class A misdemeanors. Byers is accused of hitting a family member in the face on January 3, causing bruising and redness, and of making physical contact of insulting nature with the family member on January 3 by hitting the person in the head. Charges were filed January 4.

Phillip L. Wright-Hamilton, 24, of Champaign has been charged with unlawful possession of cannabis, more than 10 grams but not more than 30 grams, a Class B misdemeanor. Wright-Hamilton is accused of possessing on December 15 more than 10 grams but less than 30 grams of a substance containing cannabis. Charge was filed January 7.

Megan A. Bruce, 28, of Charleston, has been charged with resisting or obstructing a peace officer, a Class A misdemeanor. Bruce is accused of resisting or obstructing the performance of Arcola Police Officer Anthony Roley on December 29 by refusing to remain inside her vehicle as ordered. Charge was filed January 7.

Mary K. Payne, 23, of Tuscola had been charged with non-consensual dissemination of private sexual images, a Class 4 felony carrying one to three years in prison and a fine up to \$25,000. Payne is accused of dissemi-

nating on or about October 19, 2018, without authority or permission an image of another person engaged in an act of sexual conduct—and the person being identifiable from the image alone or from information displayed in connection with the image—and said image was obtained by Payne under circumstances in which a reasonable person would know the image was to remain private. Charge was filed December 31.

Jovon L. Payton, 32, of Mattoon has been charged with four counts of aggravated driving under the influence on December 8. Charges were filed December 31.

Clete A. Weller, 31, of Humboldt has been charged with theft (\$500 to \$10,000), a Class 3 felony, and Home Repair Fraud, a Class 4 felony. Weller is accused of obtaining control of \$500 to \$10,000 cash from a person on or about March 14 with intent to deprive that person permanently of the use or benefit of the cash and of entering into an agreement for an amount exceeding \$1,000 with a person for home repair (construction and repair of a driveway at a home in Villa Grove) while at the time Weller entered into the agreement he had no intention of performing the work agreed upon. Charge

was filed January 7.
