

The Douglas County Sheriff's Office along with the Douglas County Crime Stoppers is seeking information about a burglary to Proud Mary's, located at 1003 E. Southline Road. City of Tuscola.

The burglary occurred on January 22nd, 2019, between the hours of 11:00 p.m. to 11:07 p.m. An unknown male damaged a window that was located on the east side the business, subsequently gaining entry.

The male then proceeded to the cash register located behind the bar and attempted to gain access to the contents of the cash register.

Surveillance video located at the establishment captured a portion of the crime. The Douglas County
