

30th Annual Arthur Amish Country Quilt Show April 25-27

For over three decades visitors have flocked each spring to the Annual Arthur Quilt Show and Old Fashioned Quilt Auction to see some of the finest crafted quilts you'll find anywhere. Organizers are once again excited to invite you to the Otto Center (2056 County Road 1800 East just one-half mile south of Arthur) to attend this unique, outstanding and informative event which is open from 10

a.m. to 4 p.m. Thursday and Friday. Hours on Saturday are 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

The show is set up for those who have a passion for quilting or those who just enjoy the handiwork. You can even purchase a quilt to take home with you from the one hundred high quality pieces which will be auctioned off starting Saturday, April 27 at noon.

In addition to a large variety of quilts on display

there will be scissor sharpening (Friday & Saturday), a market/vendor area plus a friendly group of volunteers who are happy to talk to you about quilting.

Judges will select a Best of Show winner plus first-, second-, and third-place winners in each of six categories: Baby, Wall Hangings, Antique, Pieced (pieced machine quilted and pieced hand quilted) and Mixed Techniques. Certificates will be awarded for Best of Show, first, second, and third place in each category and are redeemable for merchandise at participating Arthur merchants. The prize for Best of Show is a \$100 gift certificate redeemable at participating Arthur merchants. There will also be a People's Choice Award, as chosen by visitors, presented.

Those attending will also have the opportunity to enter a raffle drawing to win a queen-size quilt, Boston Commons. The drawing will take place on Saturday afternoon.

At this year's show, in honor of the 30th anniversary, there will be a special exhibition of past Best of Show quilts on display.

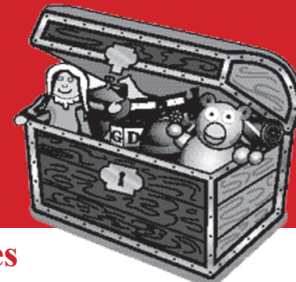

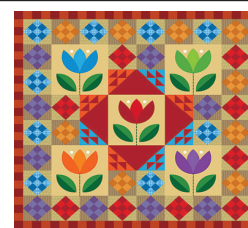
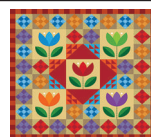
