The favorite part is being able to give people some relief. Often times, we can at least take the edge off so they can endure another day. It's nice to be able to do a treatment or therapy that takes the pressure off the nerves so that the brain can take control of the body again and start giving people relief.

Has there ever been a time that you were able to help someone that you weren't sure you would be able to help?

There are lots of times where I'm not sure I'll be able to help. I know what I need to do and I pray for that patient. I ask God to give me the ability to help the patient. I have strong faith in God and in what he has done for me and for what he intends for me to do for the patient.

If someone were looking to become a chiropractor, what sort of advice would you give them?

Good grades are important, obviously! <Smiles> Stay away from student loans, as

much as you can and I would recommend Palmer College, in Davenport. They have a very strong philosophy in the way the body functions. It's not full of therapy, but its pure chiropractic.

Would you take on a junior partner to continue the clinic here in Villa Grove?

I think Villa Grove is a great place to practice. Someone who is just coming into the practice would probably put more ours in than what I do. The overhead is low and that would help that person. Being able to support two chiropractors in our community would present its challenges, just because so many of our people go out of town. I have a good draw, up to 90 miles away.

Is there anything you would like to add? Anything I missed?

I started my practice in Dr. Cunningham's old office, which was also Chet Keller's old office, on Monroe Street in 1990. I moved to 1 North Main, across from Dr. Jones, in 92, and then we bought

this place in 95 and moved in in July of 1996. We did a lot of a construction ourselves. Our family has a good history of carpentry, with my dad and my brother, so we worked on this place pretty hard, together.

Working on it together makes it special doesn't it?

It really does. I want to add that I think Villa Grove is a good, strong place that supports their own.
