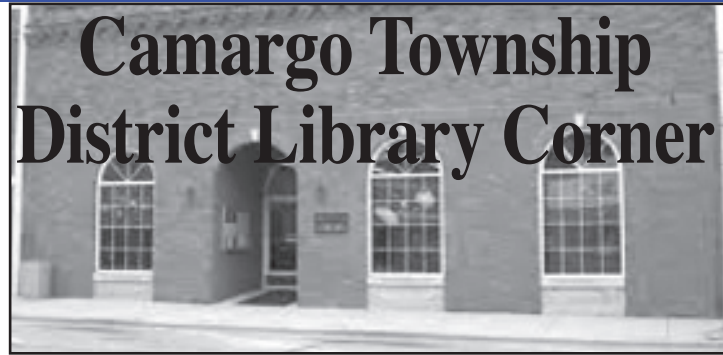


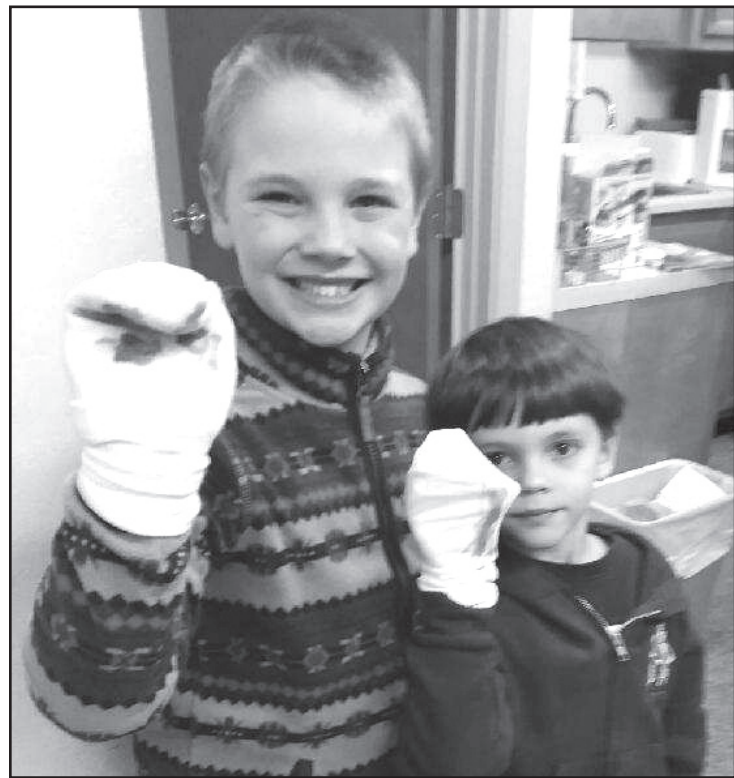

Junior High Basketball Cheerleading Tryouts for the 2019-2020 school year will be held April 5th at 6PM in the Big Gym at Villa Grove School

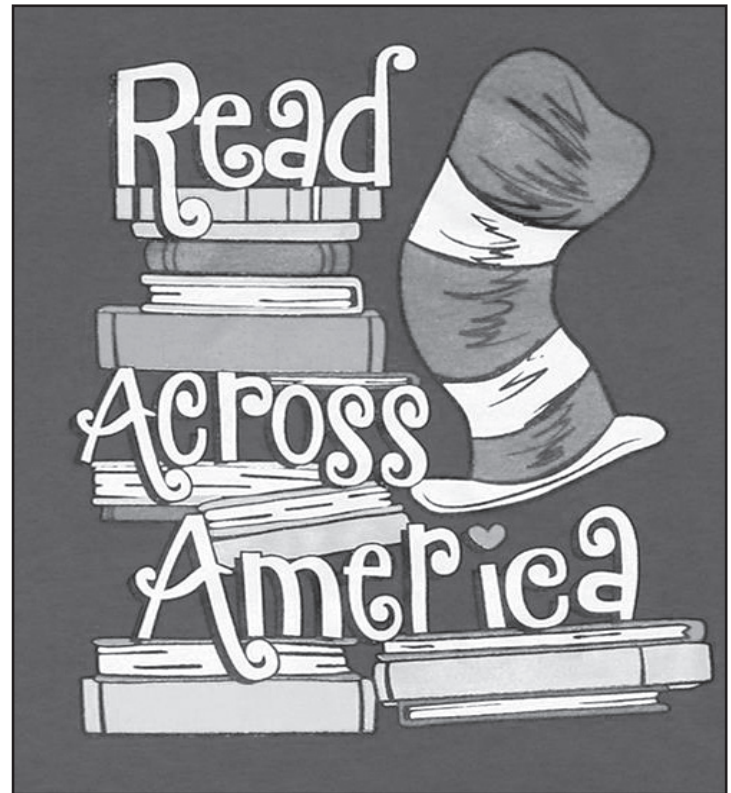
