I.O.O.F. He attended the Baptist Church. He and his wife Grace had 4 children. He died July 18, 1932.

Evan T. Howell was born in 1905 in Marion, Illinois. He was a graduate of Villa Grove High School and then from the University of Illinois with a degree in commerce and law. He was elected to congress in 1940. In 1947, he was appointed by Harry Truman to the U.S. Court of Claims. He later served as the first chairman of the Illinois State and Toll Highway Association. He resigned that

position in 1955. He and his wife had 5 children. He died in 1979.

James B. Johnson was born about 1874 in Goodland, Indiana. He came to Villa Grove in 1911 and operated a jewelry store here until his retirement. His sister Margaret was married to Albert Creek (see above). He attended the Methodist Church. He and his wife Emma had no children. He died August 16, 1955.

Dr. George L. Kennedy was born December 13, 1879 in Carp, Carleton County, Ontario, Canada. He taught

school for 2 years before entering the Chicago College of Dental Surgery in 1901. He graduated in May, 1904. Upon hearing about the "new" Villa Grove, he decided to open a practice here in June 1904. He became a naturalized citizen in 1910. Kennedy served on the school board, was a member of the village council where he served on the Water and Light Commission. He was a charter member of the Villa Grove Masonic Lodge, a charter member of the Villa Grove Rotary Club and belonged to several professional associations. He married Kathryn Rehling, a Villa Grove school teacher in June, 1906. He and his wife had 4

children. He died November 30, 1957.

Henry S. Sturm was born on May 13, 1872 in Dana, Indiana. His family later moved to a farm east of Fairland. He and his wife moved to Villa Grove in 1914. He sold insurance and real estate until he retired in 1947. He operated the Central Hotel for 25 years. Sturm served as mayor of Villa Grove for 8 years, was a Camargo Township assessor, served on the school board, was a member of the Villa Grove Masonic Lodge, Modern Woodmen, Royal Neighbors and the Odd Fellows. He attended the Methodist Church. He and his wife Nora had 2 children. He died July 8, 1951.

Alonzo "Lon" Luna was born on July 8, 1889 at Murphysboro, IL. Luna originally came to Villa Grove around 1910 as a barber. When WWI broke out, he enlisted. After the war, he returned to barbering. When the State Bank opened in 1919, he became the assistant cashier. Luna also served as the village treasurer and later became the city clerk. He was a charter member of the Villa Grove Golf Club, belonged to the Villa Grove Masonic Lodge and the V.F.W. He and his wife had no children. He died January 29, 1940.

J.D. Wyman was the first cashier when the State Bank opened its doors in November 1919. He worked there until March, 1920, when he resigned and took a position in a bank in Perrytown, Texas. There is no information on Charles Davis.
