

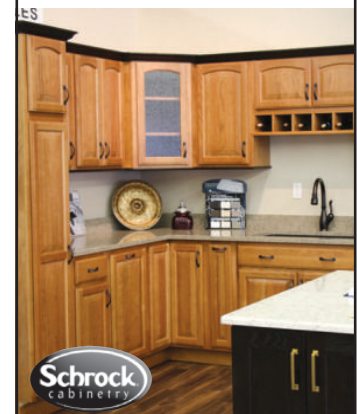
DOUGLAS COUNTY COURTHOUSE NEWS

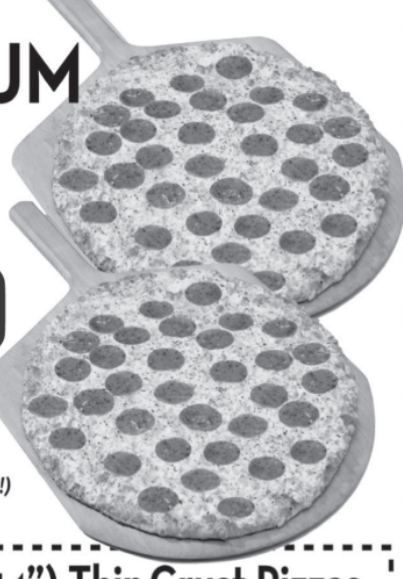
