In recognition of March being National Agriculture month, the Douglas County Farm Bureau recently donated two books to area and school libraries.

"The Great American Dust Bowl", written and illustrated by Don Brown is a graphic novel about the Dust Bowl in the 1930's. The illustrations, with shades of gray and brown, evoke the photography of the day. Survivors recollections are used as dialogue

in the story. Graphic novels are an excellent way to entice older students into reading.

"From Seed to Plant", written and illustrated by Gail Gibbons explains the relationship of seeds and plants and their life cycles. This non-fiction book has simple text and colorful illustrations for younger students. The book also includes a germination project that children can try for themselves.

Reminder From VGFD

The Villa Grove Fire Department would like to remind everyone that spring and summer bring severe weather. Please remember that the City's siren is an outdoor warning siren, so if you are inside with the air conditioning or television on, you may not hear it. If severe weather is forecasted for our area, pay attention to television and radio broadcasts for watches and warnings. Have a plan already in place as to where to go in your house. Have flashlights, water, and other supplies readily available, in case the power goes out.

The siren will be activated if

Villa Grove or a nearby town is in the path of a possible tornado and/or if spotters indicate that a tornado is in the area. The siren will not be activated for a severe thunderstorm warning. The siren is tested on the first and third Thursdays of each month, but it will not be tested if bad weather is forecasted.

Also, please remember to test your smoke detectors regularly and change the batteries when you change your clocks for daylight savings. Have a happy and safe summer.

RECYLING ROUTE CHANGE

From weekly to every other week Effective the week of 4/1/19

Dear Villa Grove Recycling Customer:

Due to a recent severe downturn in recycling commodity pricing and available markets to process recycling materials; including China and other countries, and in an effort to continue a sustainable recycling program, Advanced Disposal will be moving to an every other week recycle pick up schedule for customers currently signed up for the recycle program in the Villa Grove City Limits.

In conjunction with the City of Villa Grove, we have monitored the recycle program's volumes and found that we are picking up less than one ton of material per week. With the low volume and energy wasted, including fuel, fuel emissions, and wear and tear on City Streets, we feel an every other week schedule is the solution.

In addition to the recycle schedule change, the City has negotiated to expand Yard Waste services provided by Advanced Disposal. Advanced will now provide curbside yard waste pick ups twice a year; once in the spring and once in the fall. The dates and information regarding the yard waste pick up will be forthcoming.

Please see attached calendar for the every other week recycling pick up dates as of 04/01/19 and going forward.

Recycle will be picked up on 4/2/19; then 4/16/19, 4/30/19 and so on; every other Tuesday going forward for recycling materials.

To compensate for bi-weekly pick up volumes, we will replace the 35 gallon recycling carts with 65 gallon recycling carts. This switch will occur over the next two weeks on Tuesdays.

The change in recycling pick up weeks will not effect trash routes trash pick up in any way.
