Notice is hereby given that on May 30, 2019 at 6 p.m. CDT, Douglas County will hold a public hearing regarding the siting application of Broadlands Wind Farm LLC, pursuant to Douglas County Ordinance 09-0-04, to construct and operate a wind energy conversion system in Murdock and Newman Townships. The project will be commonly known as the Harvest Ridge Wind Farm and will involve the construction of foundations, towers, nacelles, and blades for each wind turbine, in addition to ancillary facilities, access roads and cabling, and other associated infrastructure. The wind energy project will be developed on land that is currently being used primarily for agricultural purposes.

The location of the hearing will be the Tuscola Community Building, 122 W. North Central Ave, Tuscola, IL 61953. The purpose of the hearing will be to receive public input and comment on the application. Any interested persons present will have a reasonable opportunity to be heard. In addition, written comments will be accepted and considered if received in advance of the date of the public hearing.
