

DOUGLAS COUNTY COURTHOUSE NEWS

McWethy, 24, of West Peoria or Cuba, Illinois, has been charged with possession of methamphetamine (less than five grams), a Class 3 felony carrying two to five years in prison and a fine up to \$25,000, and unlawful use of drug paraphernalia, a Class A misdemeanor carrying up to 364 days in prison and fines over \$750 but not more than \$2,500.

McWethy is accused of knowingly possessing on May 25 less than five grams of a substance containing methamphetamine and of possessing an item of drug paraphernalia, a smoking pipe, with intent to use the pipe for ingesting, inhaling, or otherwise introducing a controlled substance into the human body. Charges were filed May 29.

Rebecca N. Higgs, 27, of Newman and Shelby M. Slanker, 25, of Newman have been charged with aggravated criminal sexual abuse, Class 2 felonies carrying three to seven years in prison and fines up to \$25,000.

Higgs and Slanker are accused of committing acts of sexual penetration between November 1, 2018, and May

24, 2019, with an underage person who was between the ages of 13 and 17 when the acts occurred. Charges were filed May 29.
