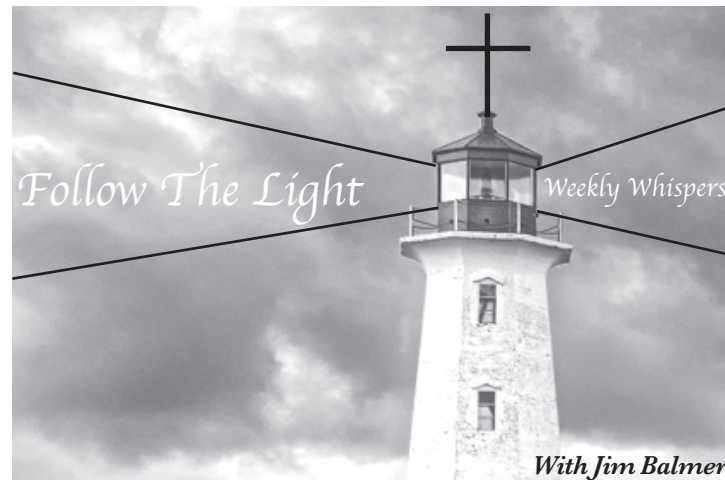
## Franklin Jennings Richardson
