'Original 9' honored for Hog legacy

The 2019 LaSalle County Fair & Wild Hog Cook-Off is dedicated to the original teams that entered the very first Wild Hog Cook-Off in March of 1980.

Aptly Named "The Original 9", they consist of: Bob Schaefer, eventual winner of the inaugural event, Bill Adami, Pres Lester, John Northcut and David Wolfe, Chris Hinojosa III and Bobby Jones, Dudley Storey III, Jonald Tiller, Jud Hillje and Ralph Boeker.

In 1980, it all began with nine teams. The "Original 9" teams that cooked up some tasty wild hog recipes for the very first La Salle County Fair and Wild Hog Cook-off created a legacy. Now, forty years later, this cook-off has grown to tremendous proportions.

As of 2019, over two hundred-fifty spots are sold out weeks before the event. With several hundred entries divided into seven different categories for teams to compete in, it has become a much-anticipated event for contestants from all over Texas.
