## The 10 Commandments of Shooting Safety-

1. Treat every gun with the respect due a loaded gun. This is the cardinal rule of gun safety.

2. Guns carried into camp or home must always be unloaded, taken down, or have actions open; guns always should be encased until reaching the shooting area.

3. Always be sure that the barrel and action are clear of obstructions.

4. Always carry your gun so that you can control the direction of the muzzle, even if you stumble. Keep the safety on until you are ready to shoot. 5. Be sure of your target before you pull the trigger.

6. Never point a gun at anything you do not want to shoot.

7. Unattended guns should be unloaded; guns and ammunition should be stored safely beyond reach of children and careless adults.

8. Never climb a tree or a fence with a loaded gun.

9. Never shoot at a flat, hard surface, or the surface of water.

10. Do not mix gunpowder and alcohol.
