The Jennie Trent Dew Library provides MIIIs County with access to books, high speed internet and much more!

Magazines and paperbacks are available. The library belongs to a digital consortium with many fiction and non-fiction titles available for download to a mobile device. The link to this consortium is located on our home page JTDlibrary.net. All card-holders have access to the TexasShare Database - a treasure trove of information.

The library offers state-ofthe-art workstations with Internet access for public use. You may set up a free Internet e-mail account online. Signing up for the computers is on a first come, first served basis. Children may use the workstations with Internet access if a parent or guardian has signed an Internet safety contract for the child.

There is no charge for the use of the computer with the exception of printing, for which we charge 25 cents per page black and white and 50 cents color.

Other software available for use on the computers includes Microsoft Office; Access (a database authoring program); Excel (a spreadsheet program); Publisher (a program for creating flyers, brochures, catalogs, and Web sites); and Word (a word-processing program). One of the workstations is equipped with a scanner.

The book drop is located on the side of the building next to the parking lot that separates the library from the Family Dollar.
