Lakeland native releases second season of hit Netflix series 'Paradise PD'

One of the unintended beneficiaries of the COVID-19 pandemic may be former Lanier County resident Waco O'Guin.

With so many people stuck in their homes, more people have discovered his Netflix show, "Paradise PD," which launched its second part on March 6.

"The timing has, accidentally, been very good for us," O'Guin said from his Burbank, California home recently, where he is self-quarantined with his family. "A lot of people are watching it. We were in the top 10 of shows on Netflix. And it's doing very well in other countries, especially France. We're really happy with that."

An animated adult comedy about a small-town police department, "Paradise PD" premiered in August of 2018 and was renewed for 20 more episodes that will come in two more parts. The second part was released March 6, with 12 more episodes originally scheduled to be released later in the year – although that may be delayed because of the pandemic. O'Guin said everybody on the show is working on the third part out of their homes currently.

"This has slowed everything down considerably," said O'Guin, a 1993 Lanier County High grad who went by Jayme O'Guin in his youth. "Everybody is working from home now, and we're working over the Internet. There a lot of kinks to work out."

O'Guin and his writing/producing partner, Roger Black, incorporated their previous animated TV comedy, "Brickleberry," into this season of "Paradise PD" (episode seven) – a crossover that was difficult.

"This season, we have a crossover with

Brickleberry on an episode, and that was a lot of fun to do," said O'Guin of his previous show, which ran for three years on Comedy Central. "There was a lot of red tape, because Comedy Central and Fox own the show, but we somehow made it happen."

O'Guin and Black created the show, serve as executive producers, and also voice certain characters (O'Guin is Robby; Black is Delbert).

"Paradise PD," O'Guin insists, is not based on any of his experiences with a small-town police department in Lanier County or Lakeland. He said a "ride along" with

a brother-in-law who's a policeman sparked the idea.

With the popularity of "Paradise PD," O'Guin hopes it will secure a long-time relationship with Netflix.

"Working with Netflix has been great," he said.

"They are distributing the series worldwide, and it's amazing how they can do that with the translations into other languages. We're very satisfied with Netflix and look forward to many years of working with them, if they'd like."

Pre-K Registration

Pre-K will begin accepting applications Monday, April 13 – Wednesday, May 13. Every Monday and Wednesday from 11:00-1:00 someone will be at the front of the school for you to drop off your registration packet.

Registration applications will be available for pick up beginning Monday, April 13 at the front of the Clinch County Elementary/Middle School. Applications will be placed in a bin and a drop box will be available for you to leave your application. We will also accept the rest of the required documentation during the week of July 27 – 31 if you can't drop it off on the designated days and times. You will need to provide the following items when turning in your applications on Mondays or Wednesdays: (Please DO NOT leave the following documentation in the drop box).

- Copy of Social Security Card
- Copy of Birth Certificate
- Eye, Ear, Dental, and Nutrition Exam (Form 3300)
- Immunization Records (Form 3231)
- Proof of Residency – landline phone, utility bill, cable bill, water bill, or a rent receipt.
- Proof of Medicaid, Snap (food stamps), or TanF (if applicable)

ALL DOCUMENTS (except Form 3300 & Form 3231) ARE REQUIRED TO BE TURNED IN BY JULY 27-31 BEFORE YOUR CHILD CAN BEGIN PRE-K. Children must be 4 years of age by September 1, 2020.
