Brayden Brewer. He is a first-year starter at safety, but has taken to the position well, according to Story. Senior Nicholas McCann will hold down the other safety spot after playing in eight games and recording 13 tackles a year ago.

"I feel good about Nicholas and Braden back there," Story said. "Brayden is my brain back there and I will depend on him to get the defense set and to be able to move around on the field."

Covering the corners will be sophomore Zyon Williams and freshman B.J. Johnson. Senior Dre Grice and freshman T.C. Cooper will see time in as defensive backs as well.

"Zyon moved over to defense at cornerback and has made some great strides," Story said. "Our freshmen have also been coming on strong."

"We are definitely young back there, but I think after a few games we will settle in well."

Story said he saw a lot of bright spots when reviewing film early Saturday morning and is looking forward to getting into practice and working on some of the less than stellar aspects.

"I thought we had way too many self-inflicted wounds, but that was somewhat expected with nine new starters," Story said. "We have guys that we are still teaching to play their positions, but that isn't an excuse. We definitely have to be more disciplined in covering our responsibilities."

"I saw some athleticism that I really am excited about and some strong play from some of our younger guys. I know we are going to keep getting better with each game."
