


Howard Oregon Van Cleave

H.O. served in WWI. All of H.O.'s brothers served in WWI as well: Neil, Ross, and Harvey. The picture below is of H.O. and his sweetheart-soon-to-be wife, Jonnie Lee Coker.

From H.O.'s and Jonnie Lee's family, their son, John Stephen Van Cleave, served in the Army during WWII. He was a private in the Army Air Force. Their daughter, my late mother-in-law, Louise Van Cleave Dahl, served



as a Rosie, the Riveter, working on the wing line for Boeing in Wichita, KS, from December, 1942, to August, 1945.


Jose Martinez
