Toast the nuts in the oven for about 10 minutes. Cream butter, 2 of the mashed bananas and sugars in a large bowl. Mix in eggs.

In a separate bowl, mix the remaining dry ingredients. Mash remaining bananas thoroughly in another bowl (3rd) and fold in pineapple, cream of coconut, and vanilla.

Fold both banana mixtures from other two bowls slowly into dry ingredients — don't over mix! Fold in the nuts. Pour batter into the pan.

Bake for about 55-60 minutes until a toothpick inserted into center of loaf comes out mostly clean, rotate pan a few times while baking (Cooking time may vary depending upon your oven).

Let the bread cool on a rack and turn out of the pan after about fifteen minutes. Let cool almost completely (approximately 45 minutes) before slicing. The bread will be very dense and moist.

PEANUT BUTTER PIE

- 1 chocolate graham cracker crust
- 1 cup peanut butter
- 1 package (8 ounces) cream cheese, room temperature
- 1 tub (12 ounces) Cool Whip, divided
- 1 jar (11.75 ounces) hot fudge, divided
- ½ cup sugar
- For the topping:**
- 2 tablespoons hot fudge
- 2 tablespoons peanut butter

In large bowl, beat peanut butter, cream cheese, and sugar until creamy. Fold in 3 cups Cool Whip. Spoon mixture into crust and smooth to edges.

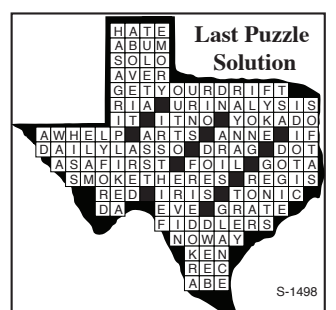
Remove 2 tablespoons hot fudge from jar and reserve in zip-loc plastic baggie for later. Heat remaining hot fudge according to package directions. Spread on top of peanut butter layer. Refrigerate pie until serving time.

At serving time, carefully spread remaining Cool Whip on top of pie.

Knead hot fudge in baggie with hands; cut tiny hole in corner of baggie and pipe over pie. Repeat with 2 tablespoons peanut butter and pipe on pie in opposite direction. Serve.

- 8 oz uncooked rigatoni

- 1 (10 oz) pack frozen spinach, thawed
- 3 c cubed, cooked chicken breasts

- 1 (8 oz) container Philadelphia chive & onion cream cheese
- ½ t salt, ½ t pepper
- ½ c shredded mozzarella cheese
