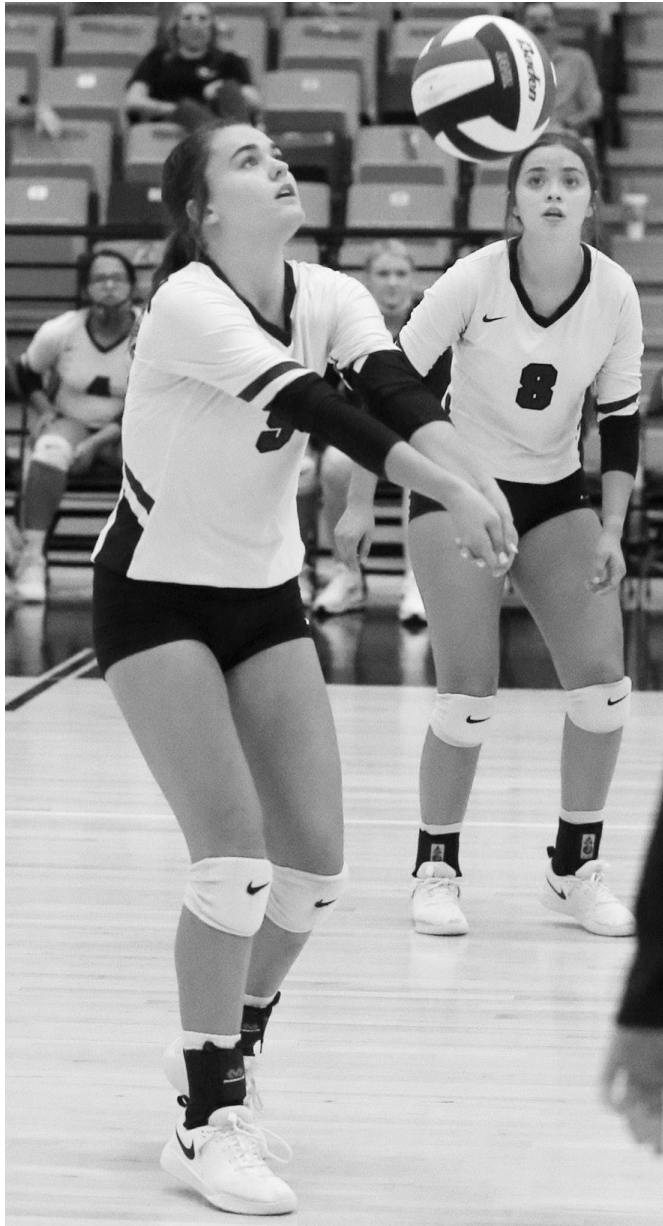


# Lady Lions open district with big win over Burk

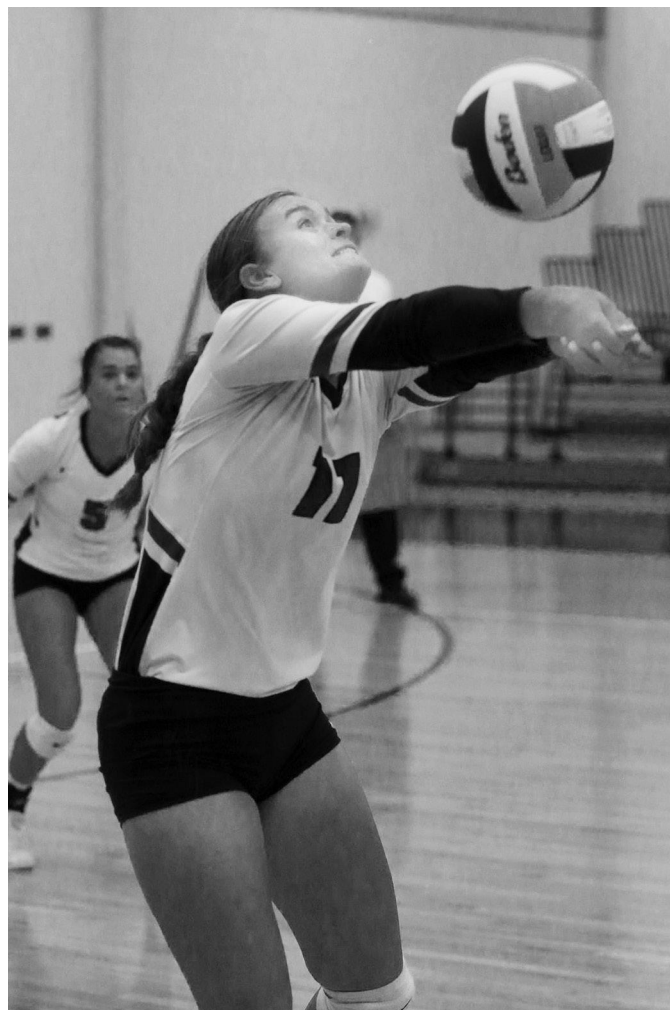
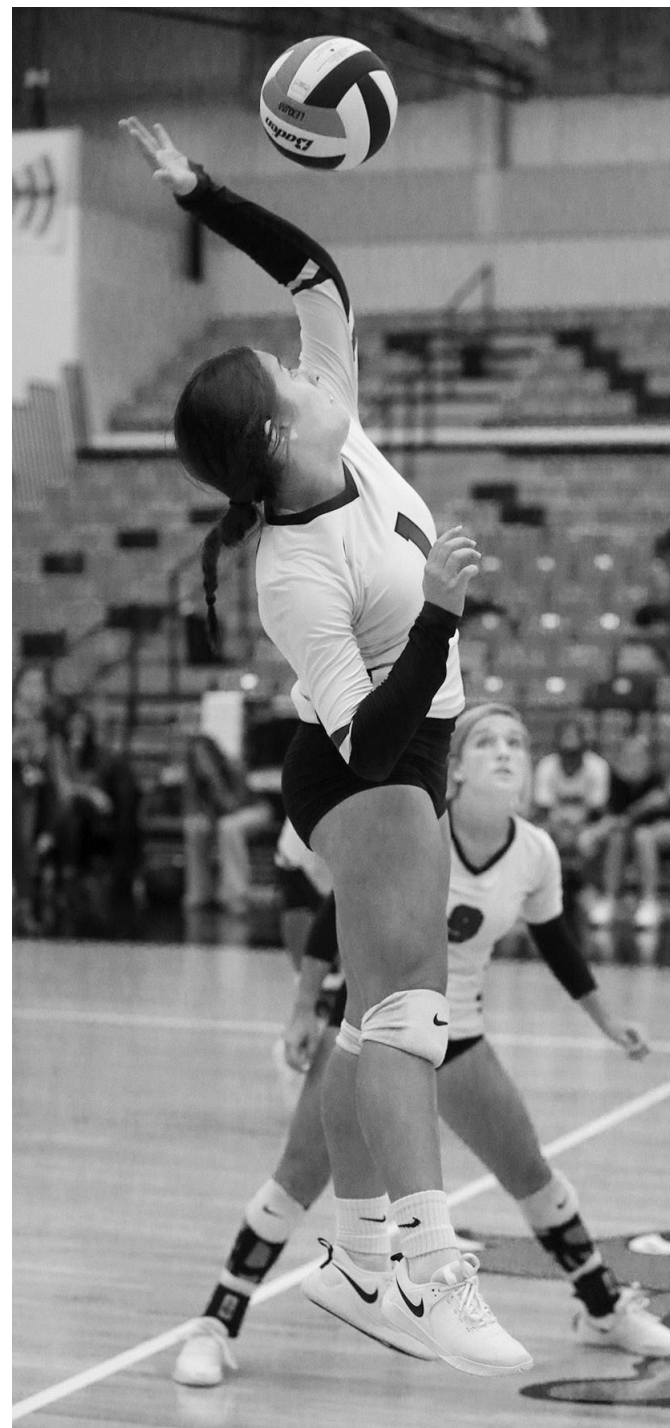


**ABOVE --** Vernon's Macy Flowers had 4 digs, 4 kills, and a block in Friday's win.

# Northside, Gold-Burg trade punches in 29-26 loss to Bears

The Northside Indians (3-2) came up short on the road Friday, falling 29-26 to Gold-Burg (3-2).

The evenly matched teams each scored four touchdowns, just like they did against each other in a scrimmage back in August. The difference was in conversions, with the Bears getting 5 points while going three for four on the conversion attempts. The Indians got 2 points while going 1 for 4.

Northside scored first on a 33-yard run on a sweep to the left down the sideline by Kameron Hooker. The conversion failed and it was 6-0. The Bears came right back, scoring and taking an 8-6 lead after one quarter.

The Indians went back up when quarterback Cody Spangler tossed a short pass to Hooker, who turned up field, broke two tackles and raced 48 yards for the score. The kick was good and Northside went up 14-8. The Bears responded and retook the lead 16-14. Northside went back in front on a 33-yard TD run by Hooker on a 2nd and 25 play. The score gave Northside a 20-16 lead at halftime.

Matthew Brooks put the Indians up 26-23 on a four-yard touchdown run in the third quarter.

Northside squandered a couple

of red zone trips in the final frame as the Bears grabbed the win with the only score of the fourth quarter.
