



## Pack your picnic basket

### Cacapon State Park

Picnic tables are situated near grills around the "circle" drive near the Nature Center. Covered pavilions can be reserved for parties or events, but other tables and grills are first come, first served. Additional tables and grills situated near the Batt Pavilion along Overlook Trail. The park is located 10 miles south of Berkeley Springs. Bathrooms and public water available. 304-258-1022 for pavilion reservations.

### Berkeley Springs State Park

A handful of tables and grills are located along Warm Springs Run in West Virginia's smallest state park in downtown Berkeley Springs. Bathrooms and public water available. 304-258-2711.

### Spruce Pine Hollow Park

Two covered picnic pavilions with tables are available for public use in this roadside park along Martinsburg Road, 8 miles east of Berkeley Springs. Primitive stone "fireplaces" can be used for cooking, with some ingenuity. Bring your own water. No amenities.

### North Berkeley Park

One covered pavilion with picnic tables open for public use. Park is located on Williams Street near the Berkeley Springs historic train depot. No grill or amenities.

### Paw Paw Municipal Park

One large covered pavilion with multiple picnic tables available for public use. Large stone grill and two smaller grills on site. Bathrooms open during events. From Paw Paw Road, follow Winchester Street to park entrance. Call Paw Paw Town Hall at 304-947-7476 for more information.

## Where to go swimming

### Berkeley Springs State Park

Pool remains open every day from June 7 through the end of summer.

Hours: Noon to 5 p.m.

### Cacapon State Park

Lake is open Tuesday through Sunday through the end of summer.

Hours: 10:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

Local swimming holes on the Cacapon River, Sleepy Creek and other small streams are mostly accessed from private property. Check before you go. Be aware of river levels and conditions before you swim.

## KIDS = PLAY

### Cacapon State Park

Playground equipment, swings, play house for all ages. Located along the central picnic circle area of the park. Bathrooms and water fountains nearby. Park is located 10 miles south of Berkeley Springs.

### North Berkeley Park

Playground and fitness equipment, plus a paved walking track and picnic table pavilion on Williams Street in Berkeley Springs. No amenities.

### Morgan County sports complex

Playground equipment next to the county soccer fields. Located along U.S. 522 south of Berkeley Springs on the east side of the road.

Across U.S. 522 is the county's baseball and softball field complex. Fields used by leagues during the season, but open to the public.

Bathrooms nearby.

### Paw Paw Municipal Park

Playground equipment and playing fields near Paw Paw Schools in western Morgan County. Bathrooms open during events.

### Local schools

Playground equipment for elementary age kids is used when school isn't in session.
