



Palm Beach County and the State of Florida have shut down all the public boat ramps. If your vessel is on a trailer on your property you legally can't launch your vessel from a public boat ramp. If your vessel is located at a marina you can take the boat out, just don't congregate at the sand bars or islands in the Intracoastal waterway, or go offshore and visit a beach. The inland water-

way is open to navigation, you can still refuel your vessel, or visit an on-shore Intracoastal facing restaurant for take-out service. The Keys have closed their doors to northern tourists and Florida non-Keys residents. Social media posts from the larger guide and marinas are posting beautiful pictures of dead fish held up by a human. But look closer and you'll notice heavy coats on

some anglers, indicating an older picture.

Seas have been flat, and the fishing has been fair. Salt and brackish water fishing from a bridge have turned up a few mangrove snapper along with sand perch. Small barracuda and an assortment of less desirable fish have been biting. Before the public boat ramps closed, I had been targeting snook with some success.

So, until the all-clear is given and the State and federal governments open society back up, stay safe, practice social distancing and enjoy your quarantine period. As of today, I've been in self-quarantine for 14 days.

Freshwater anglers can't use public boat ramps either. Private boat ramps are OK, but you have to

know the right people. Once again Lake Osborne is open you just can't use a public boat ramp to launch your vessel. If your boat is already in the water, you can navigate the eastern lake and canal chain where you will find fair bass catches. Just don't beach the vessel, so keep moving and no congregating.

Canoes and kayak use from private property is OK, but you are not supposed to launch into Lake Osborne from Lake Osborne Drive. Technically, the entire parking area is closed for that purpose. However, you can park if you are biking, walking, strolling, running or fishing from the bank while practicing social distancing. Large groups will be asked (told) to disperse.

## Ever Since You Worked on My Car.....

As I wrote here in this column a few weeks ago it takes nerves of steel dealing with the public, case in point: Last week we did a right rear wheel brake caliper replacement on a 2004 Buick.

The job went well with no issues. Two hours after the customer left he came back and said to me with a sad look on his face, "I have a leak, come look at it." I put my lunch down and did.

I suspected that maybe the technician did not tighten the part properly or that the brake hose was left loose after bleeding the brakes. So I walk out to the car and as I started to walk towards the right rear wheel he called me to the front of the car and pointed around the area of the back of the front tires.

Now this car sits here for six months by the ocean and I suspected a rusted brake line up front since the job we did stopped the brake fluid leak in the right rear.

I knelt down and saw the drain from the air conditioner doing its job by draining the condensed water from the a/c ( he had left the car running with the air on). I pointed that out to him and he said, "What about the leak on the drivers side?"

On this particular car the air conditioner hoses go around to the drivers side firewall as opposed to the passenger side. I looked at the a/c hose on the drivers side by the firewall near the left front tire of course and saw..... condensation on the hose which is perfectly normal. I said it was, he looked sheepishly at me and said he was sorry he wasted my time, he did not know where the water was coming from.
