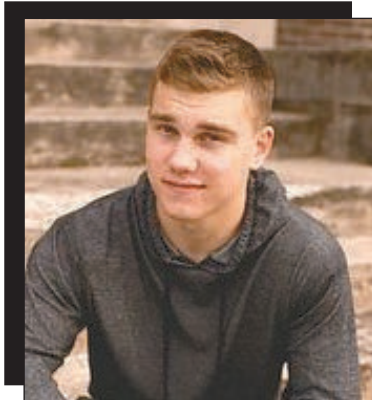
Favorite Class:

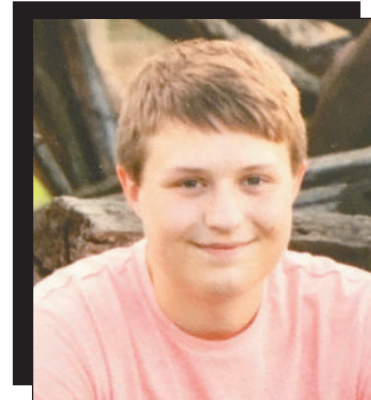
