The Academic Team consists of four different competition areas: Quick Recall (team event), Future Problem Solving (4-person writing event), Written Assessments (individual event, 50-question multiple choice tests in 5 categories: Mathematics, Language Arts, Science, Arts and Humanities, and Social Studies), and Composition (individ-

ual writing event). Students can compete in 3 different events, with each written assessment counting as one event. Mrs. Godby has coached the RCHS Academic Team since 2005 (with a two-year hiatus 2009-2011). Dalton Robertson began as assistant coach last year, and this year has led the Quick Recall Team.

The RCHS Academic team competes in the Green River Regional Academic League in the Fall to prepare for the KAAC District Governor's Cup competition in January. This past Fall the team struggled to get enough members to compete but ended the league season prepared to battle in the District tournament.

RCHS hosted the KAAC District Governor's Cup competition over the weekend of January 25th. The District includes Adair Coun-

ty, Green County, Casey County, and Russell County. FPS teams and Composition competed on Tuesday, January 21st, while written assessments and the quick recall tournament were held on Saturday, January 25th. The FPS team placed 2nd, and will be advancing to Region competition. Taylor Abernathy placed 1st in Composition, advancing her to Region competition. Samuel Leveridge placed 2nd in Mathematics and 3rd in Science, advancing him to Region competition in both areas, while Allie Burton placed 4th in Mathematics advancing her to Region competition. The Quick Recall Team placed 2nd in the tournament, advancing them to Region competition. Overall, the team won Runners-Up for the 2020 KAAC District Governor's Cup Competition.
