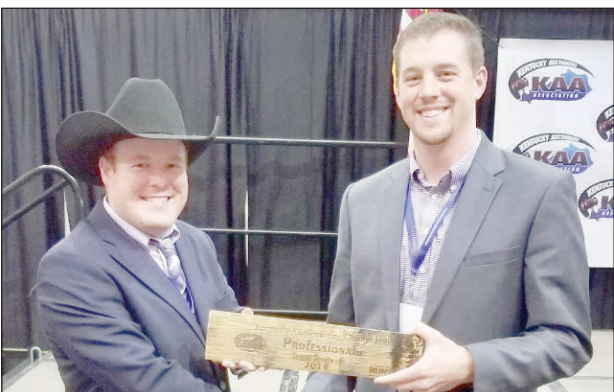
They do not accept any hazardous material, trash, paint cans, computers or laptops etc.

In 2019, Russell County raised \$3,310.00 through the Ag Tag Voluntary Donation program. That's money that goes directly to Kentucky 4-H, Kentucky FFA and Kentucky Proud to support our agriculture community (and its future) here locally and across the Commonwealth.

## Saving Money on Student Taxes!

Income tax season is here, and students may want to consider these tips to help the process go more smoothly.

Although students may not have earned enough to be required to file, they may be able to get a refund if their employer withheld taxes from their pay. Before they file, they should discuss the situation with their parents. If parents can claim the student as a dependent, the parents could save thousands of dollars. Nearly all high school students will be considered dependents for tax purposes. If you have more questions, please talk to your CPA for guidance in the right direction.

Students and parents may be able to take advantage of these programs on their federal taxes:

- American Opportunity Credit, available for

the first four years of college.

- Lifetime Learning Credit, available if a tax-payer or a dependent is taking college courses to acquire or improve job skills.
