

# Russell County Take a look at OUR CHILDREN!

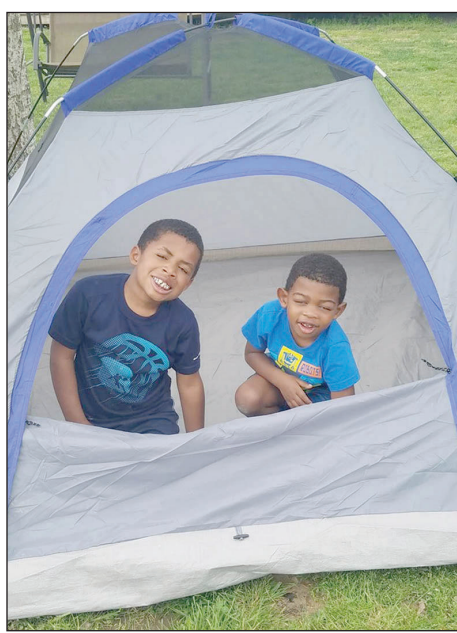

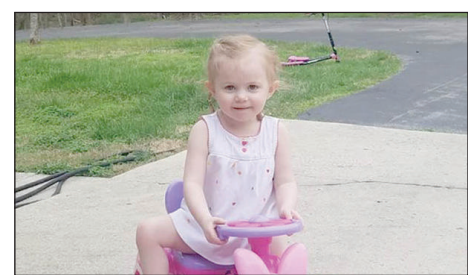

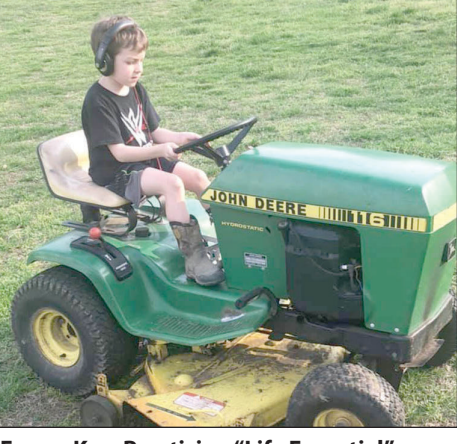

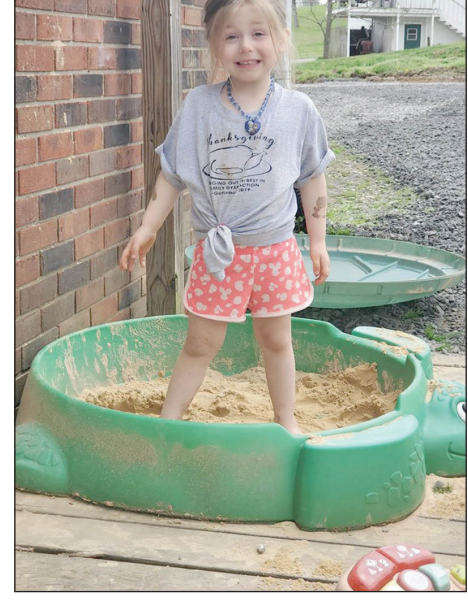
