Using Summer Annuals to Reclaim Hay Feeding Areas

Wet conditions this winter resulted in almost complete disturbance in and around hay feeding areas.

Regardless of the reclamation strategy you use, it always important to create an environment that allows seeds to germinate quickly and uniformly

Damaged areas should be soil tested, and lime and fertilizer applied as needed.

Be aware that the COVID-19 pandemic has changed how UK accepts soil testing samples.

In most cases, feeding areas need complete renovation each spring.

Summer annual grasses planted in the late spring or early summer have the highest probability of successful establishment.

To help your summer annual grasses get established, make sure you use the high end of the recommended seeding rate.

Allow taller growing summer annuals like sorghum-sudangrass and pearl millet to reach a height of 18-24 inches before grazing.
