Mask are Mandatory **Effective May 11**

Last week Governor Andy Beshear discussed the details on re-opening the state of Kentucky. This will not be a fast-paced process, as Kentuckians have already seen. However, Governor Beshear wants to reopen while continuing the steps already put in place to keep Kentuckians safe from COVID-19.

According to WBKO, Governor Beshear announced new regulations and goals for the "Healthy at Work" initiative. One regulation will be that all Kentuckians will have to wear a mask in public by May 11. Beshear said people who do not follow the guidelines will not be cited, but they will be asked to put on masks. Another part of the new regulation is that it is mandatory for businesses. Businesses not masking could be grounds for temporary closure.
