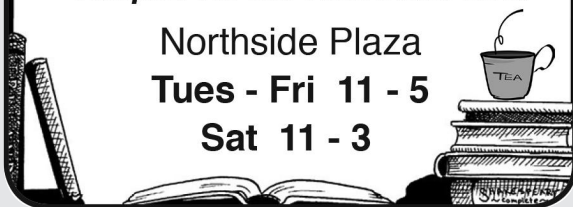

## Russell Bellamy Exhibits At CF

The College of Central Florida Webber Center is excited to announce the opening of "Pre-Conception," a solo exhibition of sculptures by Russell Bellamy, and the official reopening of the Webber Gallery to the public. The exhibition will run from Oct. 12- Nov. 5.

Bellamy's artwork utilizes industrial materials and processes to comment on labor, sociological/psychological structures, and behavioral expectations. He is influenced by the proximity of urban and rural landscapes and the mutually beneficial structures and aesthetics that create the areas and spaces in between. Bellamy is currently an associate professor of Art and department chair at Beacon College.
