The 1st Brigade, PACS, Inc. a non-profit Living History/Civil War reenactment organization will be hosting its annual Ocklawaha River Raid Civil War Re-enactment and Living History weekend Oct. 31 - Nov. 1, at the Florida Horse Park on Hwy. 475 west of Belleview.

The event commemorates the March 1865 Union Army raid along the Ocklawaha River that resulted in the only battle of the war to occur in Marion County.

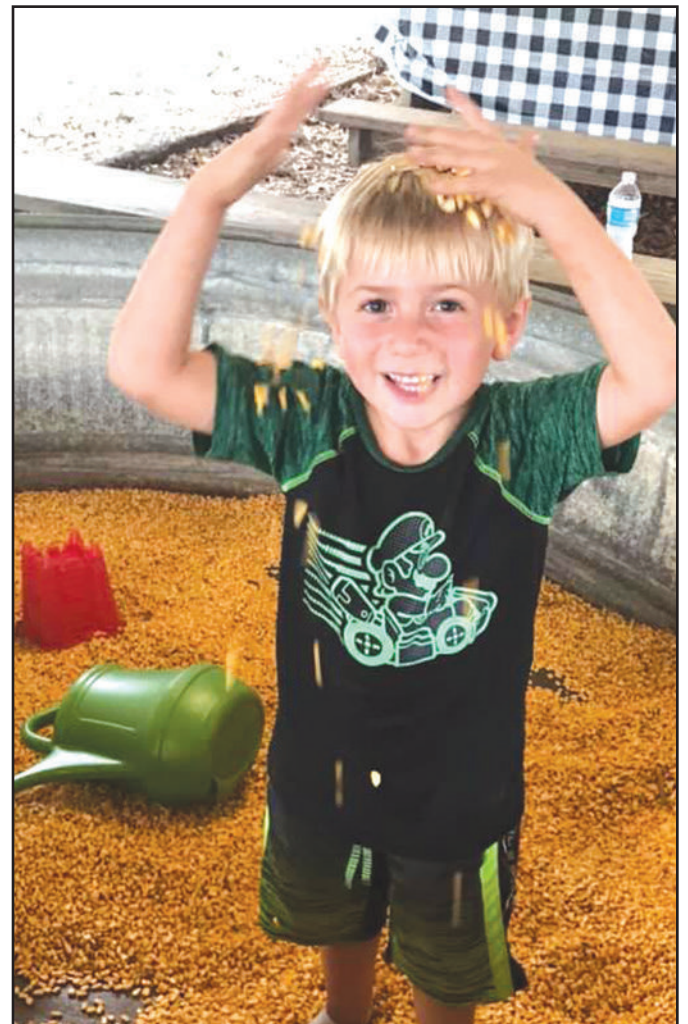
