

# 12th Region Hall of Fame Inducts 13

The 2020 Hall of Fame inductees for the 12th Region Sports of Kentucky were honored during the championship game Tuesday night between East Jessamine and Danville.

Players nominated for this honor include three former Mercer County natives, Marty Pulliam, Terry Mobley and Joe White; one Burgin alumni, Alex Beckerson; one Garrard County player, Spencer Crutchfield; one player from Laurel County, Jorden Hammonds and three brothers from Monticello, John, Kermit and David Perkins.

Pulliam scored 1,332 points, had 1,212 rebounds and was a member of Louisville's 1980 National Champions.

Mobley led Harrodsburg to the 1960 state tournament, was all central kentucky conference, all region, all state and averaged 12.3 points per game at the University of Kentucky.

White led Mercer's team to the Sweet 16 in 2000, was three time all district, two time all region and played at Tennessee Wesleyan College.

Beckerson scored 1,549 career points, with 762 rebounds, was two time all district, all region and led his team to 22 wins in 2012 and played at Thomas More College.

Crutchfield scored 1,145 career points, all Region in 2004 and led Garrard County to their last regional appearance.

Hammonds was two time all district, all region, played on three regional champion teams in the 12th and 13th regions and was a member of the 2005 state championship team.

John Perkins played on four consecutive 20 win teams, two time all district, two time all region and played

at Somerset Community College.

Kermit Perkins scored 1,059 career points, scored 23 to lead his team to the 1967 regional championship, three time all district, two time all region and played at the University of New Orleans where his team won the Division 2 national championship.

David Perkins scored 1,260 career points, was two time all district and all region, holds the record for most points in a single season and played at Murray State and Cumberland College where

he scored over 1,000 points.

This is the first time three brothers have been inducted into the 12th Region Hall of Fame.

Coach Bill Riddle, from Rockcastle was also honored. Riddle led Broadhead to the State Tournament in 1972.

Contributor Glen Profit was honored for his continued sponsorship of the 12th Region Junior All Star games for last 15 years and was an inductee as a contributor.

Athletic Director Dean Geary was

inducted because he has served as athletic trainer since 1988, has also served as the athletic director, president of 12th region athletic directors and 12th region policy board.

Blake Upchurch was honored for his 29 consecutive years of service to Wayne County School as either a manager or videographer.

All the honorees have made basketball for the 12th region sports a part of their lives.
