They will start their season on Friday, Sept.

18, with an away game against the Bath County Wildcats.

It will make for an interesting game week one for the Golden Lions. Wildcats Head Coach Johnny Poynter has done a good job in recent years, leading the team to several winning records. Regardless of the adversity, Garrard hope to start off with a win to start the year.
