Governor: Mississippi seeing its 'worst' spread of COVID-19

A mask mandate and other restrictions took effect Monday in 13 of Mississippi's 82 counties as the state continues to see a rapid increase in cases of the new coronavirus, including a steady rise in hospital patients.

"This is the worst that We All Scream - For Ice July is National Ice Cream it's ever been for spread of cases in our state," Republican Gov. Tate Reeves said some during a news conference Monday.

> Figures released Monday by the state Health Department showed 1,020 people were hospitalized with confirmed or suspected cases of COVID-19 Sunday. That is up from 664 on June 22.

> The state health officer, Dr. Thomas Dobbs, said eight hospitals in Mississippi had no beds available in their intensive care units as of Monday. Four of those were in the Jackson area. He also said long-term care facilities are seeing an increase of cases because of transmission in communities. Even if people can't visit loved ones in nursing homes, employees go in and out.

House Bill 1796 established a commission to redesign the Mississippi State Flag. The Mississippi Department of Archives and History (MDAH), which is providing clerical support for the commission, is now accepting flag design submissions. The sole purpose of the commission, according to the bill, is to develop, design, and report to the governor and the legislature its recommendation for the design of the new state flag no later than September 14, 2020.

Criteria 1. Only unique flag design submissions that include the words "In God We Trust" will be considered by the nine-member commission. Flag descriptions will not be considered.

2. The new flag design cannot include the Confederate battle flag.

3. Flag design submissions must adhere to principles of the North American Vexillological Association:

• Keep It Simple. The flag should be so simple that a child can draw it from memory.

• Use Meaningful Symrelate to what it symbolthe spread of the virus. He said he has heard about "mask shaming" directed at people who cover their faces and at people who don't.

Mississippi has a population of about 3 million. The Health Department said Monday that the state has had at least 36,680 confirmed cases and at least 1,250 deaths from the coronavirus as of Sunday evening. That was an increase of 393 cases and one death from numbers reported the day before.

The department said at least 3,000 cases of the virus have been confirmed in longterm care facilities such as nursing homes, with at least
