 The Office of Geology has received an Application for a Surface Mining Permit pursuant to Sections 53-7-27 and 53-7-29 of the Mississippi Surface Mining and Reclamation Act of 1977, as described below:

**LOCATION:** West 1/4 of Southwest 1/4 of Section 15, Township 13 North, Range 1 East, Holmes County (Lat. N32° 58' 28.63", Long. W90° 11' 31.80")  
**DESCRIPTION:** The operator proposes to amend an existing 35-acre surface mine by adding 40 acres for a total disturbance of 75 acres to a total depth of 60 feet for sand and gravel. Sediment and erosion will be controlled by settling ponds, drainage ditches, and diversion berms. Reclamation will consist of 3 to 1 grassed slopes and a lake.  
 This public notice is being distributed to interested persons and agencies to assist in developing facts on which a decision by the Office of Geology can be based. You are requested to communicate the information contained in this notice to any other parties whom you deem likely to have interest in the matter. All agencies and persons shall have until September 11, 2020, to submit com-

ments, recommendations, or evaluations to the Office of Geology. Comments by an agency shall include an enumeration of permits or licenses required under the agency's jurisdiction.  
 If further information is needed, an agency may be furnished a copy of the notice of intent or permit application. Any person may inspect the permit application as specified in Section 104 of the Rules and Regulations.  
 In the event comments are not received by September 11, 2020, the Office of Geology will consider that the agency has no comments, recommendations and/or evaluations that the agency deems necessary and proper based upon the effect of the proposed operation on matters within the agency's jurisdiction.

### TAX LEVIES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020 - 2021 HOLMES COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

This Board of Supervisors for Holmes County, Mississippi, having fully and carefully considered the needs and requirements of the various funds of the County and of the taxing district within the County, and the tax rates which are required to produce the necessary revenues from ad valorem taxation during the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2020, and now, to comply with the requirements of the applicable state laws regarding such taxation in particular Section 27-39-317. Mississippi Code 1972;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following tax rates or levies be, and they are hereby, fixed, imposed, and levied for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2020, upon the assessed value of all property in Holmes County, Mississippi, or on the property as set forth in each Section of this Order, as such property is now assessed and listed, and as may hereafter be assessed and listed upon assessment rolls of Holmes County as of January 1, 2020, including the assessment rolls of motor vehicles as provided by the Motor Vehicle Ad Valorem Tax Law of 1958 (Section 27-51-1. et seq.) for county taxes, with the exception of the exempt assessed value of homestead to the extent exempted by law;

NOTE: The statutory authority hereinafter cited is of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended.
