Arrests made after suspects evade law enforcement

Three suspects wanted by the Lexington Police Department were all apprehended within the past three weeks.

Lexington Chief of Police John Newton reported that Charles Williams, 25, Alize Anderson, 24, and Adrien Howard, 25, were arrested and charged with felony crimes.

Adrien Howard was apprehended in Dallas, Texas, by the U.S. Marshals on September 10. Howard is

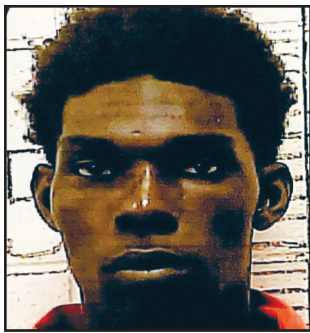
