

Hinds County 4H Robotic team members recently came together to refresh, review, and upgrade their knowledge and skillset for developing, programming, and improving simple robot functions that may possibly help to improve daily life tasks in the future.

4H'ers were briefed on robotics-related employment opportunities, college degrees in robotics, computer science and other STEM-related majors, the future of human employees versus robotic employees, and educational advances towards robotic importance for the state.

The paired teams also used sensor Robotix crabs to race and maneuver obstacle courses during robotics workshop. They brainstormed company names, logos, possible start-up costs, tasks for robotic performance, and design and programming upgrades to improve robot functions and accuracy.

Clintonian Rocheryl Ware, Mississippi State University Extension Agent in Hinds County, says she is proud of the progress her 4H'ers and other youth are making and thinks that there is great hope for the state in the future for advances in education, employment, and a capable workforce.
