Kids Towne community workday set for March 28

After the previous one had to be cancelled due to inclement weather, the City of Clinton has rescheduled a community workday to rebuild Kid's Towne Park and install the new playground equipment.

On Saturday, March 28, volunteers of all ages are encouraged to show up at the park on Old Vicksburg Road to help. The community workday is scheduled from 8 a.m. until 4 p.m..

The community-involved installation will highlight the City of Clinton's commitment to preserving and enhancing the legacy of the twentythree-year-old community-built park. Involving the community in the renovations will serve as a reminder of the significant contributions of those who worked diligently to make the park a reality over two decades ago, when the park was built as a Leadership Clinton project that encompassed the entire community in its scope.

Kid's Towne Park was closed on November 6, 2019, to allow for crews to remove the existing wooden playground. Installation of the new playground was slated for completion and reopening on January 27, but the installation had to be delayed in order to al-



low the site to have additional preparation work done. Another workday was scheduled for late February, but rainy weather caused it to be postponed.

Once completed, Kid's Towne will join Robinson Park in Clinton as the second PlayCore Play-On! public playground in Mississippi. Play On! structures are built towards allowing children to exercise while playing on the playground equipment.
