Board approves advertisement of bids for Cynthia Road Bridge reconstruction project

Permanent repairs to the Cynthia Road Bridge near Magnolia Road are getting closer to reality. Consulting City Engineer Bill Owen and Clinton Public Works officials recently requested approval to advertise for bids to replace the wooden pilings with concrete pilings for a stronger and longer lasting bridge.

Bids will be taken on April 8. A construction timeline and road closure information will be available once the contract is awarded to a contractor.


In winter of 2018, City officials temporarily closed the bridge to repair wooden pilings that were deemed insufficient to handle the traffic volume and weight loads utilizing the roadway. Following several weeks of repairs to several pilings, the bridge was reopened to traffic with a reduced weight limit.

The short-term repair extended the life of the bridge and provided an opportunity for a long-term solution to be designed and funded. Once funding was allocated from Hinds County in 2019, designs and engineering plans were created.

According to Clinton Mayor Phil Fisher, "a permanent fix has been our ultimate goal, and this bridge replacement is an important component in upgrading our infrastructure for the next generation."
