

City of Clinton releases 2020 street paving and improvement list

City of Clinton officials have released the 2020 street paving and improvements list on the City website at ClintonMS.org/streets. Bids for the 2020 projects have been advertised, and improvements will begin in the summer once bids are received and a contractor named.

The City has budgeted over \$1,100,000 for the 2020 Striping and Paving projects.

Plans are to begin milling, paving and striping the roads in early June, and work should be completed within the contractually mandated period.

According to Mayor Phil Fisher, streets were graded and prioritized based on need for paving or striping. Fisher noted that the striping and paving project is "well overdue."

In addition, Magnolia Road construction of nearly \$1,000,000 will continue through the summer. In all, over \$2,000,000 will be spent in 2020 to pave and rehabilitate roads.

Gill Drive, from McRaven Road to the dead end

Laurelwood Drive, from Shady Glen Drive to the dead end

Countrywood Circle

Huntcliff Way from Pinehaven Road to Northside Drive

Keith Lane, from Pinehaven Road to the dead end

Kent Drive, from Cynthia Road to Oak Hill Circle

Scotland Road, from Lindale Circle to Cardinal Lane

Spanish Oak Drive, from Springridge Road to Pebblebrook Dr.

Sweetgum Lane, from Trailwood Drive to the cul-de-sac

Warwick Road, from Lakeridge Lane to the dead end

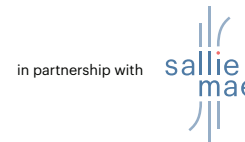
