A new exterior icon was recently installed above the front door of Holy Resurrection Orthodox Church on College Street in Clinton.

“Most Orthodox think of this image as the icon of the Resurrection,” said Fr. Paul Yerger, pastor of Holy Resurrection. “To be specific, it depicts the descent of Christ into Hades. Christian tradition (alluded to in 1 Peter 4:18) is that when our Lord died on the cross, He went on to descend among the dead. In the icon, we see Him descending into the darkness of death, not as a prisoner like others; but as a conqueror, bringing a brilliant light of victory. The gates of Hades

lie broken at His feet. His arms are extended to lift Adam and Eve and all the dead from their coffins to be raised with Him. Death is swallowed up in victory.”

The icon was painted by iconographer Vladimir Grigorenko of Dallas. It is set in a wood frame designed by Al Lawson and built by Brooks Pettit. With its frame, the icon is about ten feet in height and six feet wide. It was installed by FMS Lighting of Jackson.

The icon is a memorial to Matushka Sissy Yerger, late wife of Fr. Paul Yerger.
