

H.O.O.T. GOES ON, DESPITE PANDEMIC



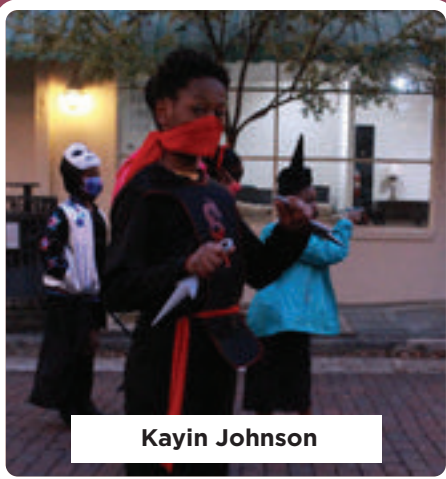

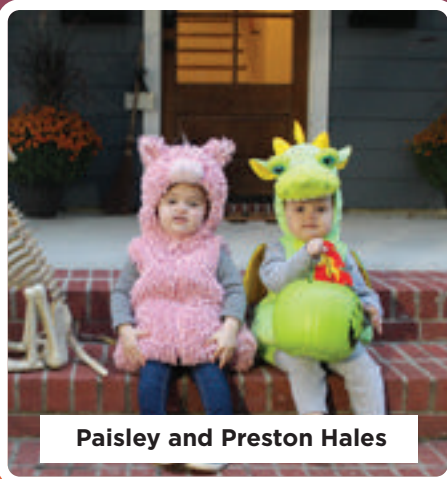
