preparation of city payroll and bills. Her duties are to prepare and print checks for the next two (2) pay periods unless extended by the city council. This is to allow the new City Clerk to be trained in this area of responsibility. A motion to appoint Ms. Mentzer was made by Alderwoman Thomas with a second by Alderman Warnol and carried on a role call vote of 5 to 0.

Mayor Kuehl then addressed the council concerning training required for Ms. Pennington to perform her duties and stated that a training portal had been setup with g-Works for training on the Summit software system. This training would be conducted online starting March 19th. The mayor also notified the council that Ms. Pennington had taken and passed the test to become a notary and would apply for a notary seal.

Mayor Kuehl addressed the council concerning the election in April and that as the City Clerk Ms. Pennington would be the city's election official, he also addressed the possibility that the election may be postponed due to the Coronavirus outbreak.

(NOTE: Missouri Governor Mike Parson has issued an order moving the April municipal election to June 2, 2020.)

Signature Cards, Locks Addressed
Alderman Warnol made a motion to amend the agenda at this time to address the signature cards for the city accounts and the rekeying of the locks in City Hall. This motion was seconded by Alderman Null and carried on a roll call vote of 5 to 0.

Alderwoman Thomas made a motion to rekey the locks, make new access codes, put the copy of the codes in the city's safe deposit box and purchase a new door

opener for the Maintenance Department garage door with a second by Alderman Campbell. This motion passed on a vote of 5 to 0.

This being the last item for the council to consider Alderwoman Thomas made a motion to adjourn the meeting with a second by Alderman Warnol. The motion carried on a unanimous show of hands vote and the meeting adjourned at 6:50 p.m.

state business, where strict compliance with such requirements and rules would prevent, hinder, or delay necessary action by the department of health and senior services to respond to a declared emergency or increased health threat to the population."

The Executive Order requires local election authorities to publish notice of the June 2 election as required in Section 115.127.2, RSMo. In addition, the Executive Order states:

The closing date to register to vote in this election remains

March 11.

The deadline for filing as a write-in candidate for office remains March 27 at 5:00 p.m.

The deadline to apply for an absentee ballot (Section 115.279, RSMo) shall be May 20.

A public test of voting equipment shall be completed no later than June 1.

In-person absentee ballots may be cast until 5:00 p.m. on June 1.

The deadline by which absentee ballots must be received by the election authority (Section 115.293.1, RSMo) shall be 7:00 p.m. on June 2.

Military and overseas voters

must request a ballot from an election authority by 5:00 p.m. on May 29, and the deadline for local election authorities to make ballots available to such voters is April 18. Military and overseas ballots must be received by the election authority by June 5.

Local election authorities are also directed to post information on their website, use social media if available, issue press release, conduct public appearances, and directly contact stakeholders such as candidates.
