Clayton Sinden started on the mound for Dixon and took the loss. He went into the seventh before being relieved. Going 6 2/3 innings, Sinden gave up seven runs but only four were earned. He allowed seven hits, struck out four and walked four.

Coach Alex Shelton stated, "Game 2 was a roller coaster game. Clayton Sinden started out very strong for us on the mound and we were forced to ride him deep, probably a little longer than we would have liked, as this was our 4th game in 2 days, and our pitching was depleted."
