CLAIRE O'CONNOR

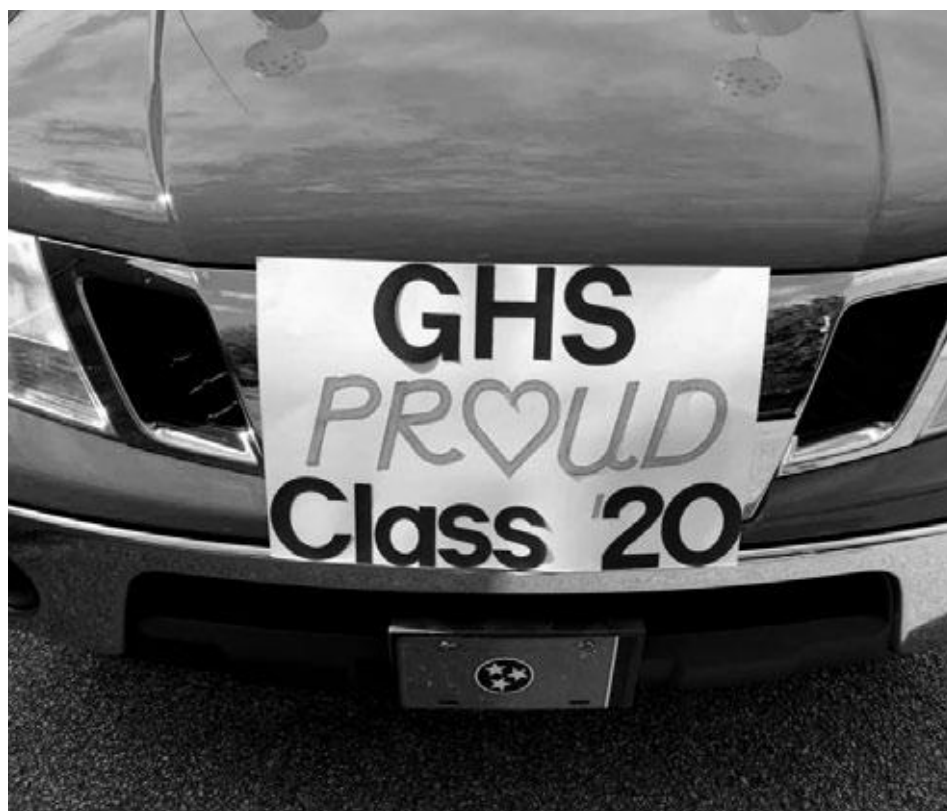
Claire O'Connor is the daughter of Mike and Kristy O'Connor. She has earned a

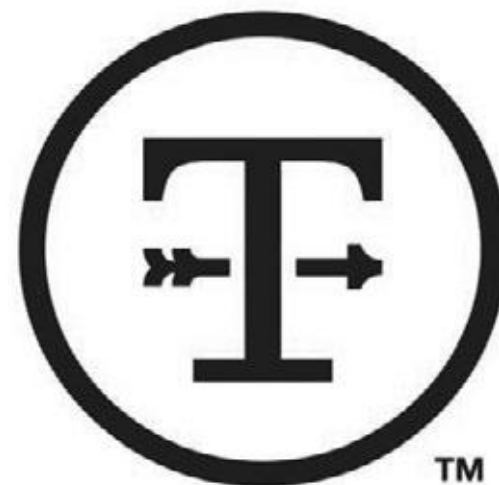
