



#### **GS Make Temporary Changes to Safeguard Members & Family**

Girl Scouts of Central Illinois (GSCI) is announcing that they are joining sister Girl Scout Councils and national and local efforts to contain and reduce the risk of COVID-19 exposure.

All GSCI gathering places, offices, camp properties as well as cookie cupboards associated with those gathering places, will be closed effective immediately. Staff will transition to working remotely, still focused on delivering

support in these unprecedented times. White GSCI has no reason to believe any of their girls or volunteers are affected by the coronavirus, they're encouraging all girls and volunteers to exercise discretion and follow all Girl Scout and CDC safety protocols.

As this is a fluid situation, GSCI will be making assessments 2-3 weeks in advance of upcoming events, programs, gatherings etc., and as the CO-

VID-19 situation changes we will keep members updated," GSCI CEO Pam Kovacevich said.
