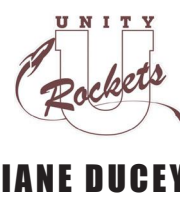


ROCKET NATION

Tolono Library: Take Home Craft Kits; Children's Candy Art Contest

We welcome you to come into the library and loo; for books, audio books, magazines and movies. Our current hours are different to accommodate a broad range of patrons. We are dedicating 9-10 am, M-F for patrons who are considered high risk (seniors and people with underlying health issues). The general public is welcome to come in from 12-7pm, M-F and 12-3pm on Sat/Sun. We still offer curbside pick up for anyone who would like to make a quick stop for picking up their items. Please call the library to schedule a curbside pick up time. Most of the time, if you order any materials that are in our library you can get those items the same day or the next. We continue many of our cleaning routines and sanitation practices to make sure you are safe while in the library and we ask that you comply with our rules to help keep everyone safe as well. Masks are required to be in place before coming into the library and we ask that the mask stays in place the entire time you are inside the library. We have special accommodations for curbside pick ups for those who are unable to wear a mask. Accommodation sheets are on the white table just inside the lobby. We are asking that families stay together during their time at the library. Children need to stay with parents. Unfortunately, at this time we do not have games, puzzles, or activities. The play area is closed as well. We hope all families understand that we feel these measures are for the health and safety of all our patrons. Three of our patron computers will be available for use on a sign-up basis. We are limiting use to a half hour per guest. Our drop boxes are open! You may place your items in any of the drop boxes at any time. Please only put items you've checked out from the Tolono Library in the drop boxes. Champaign

and Urbana items need to be returned to them and not put in our drop boxes. Please do not place book donations in the drop boxes. We are unable to accept book donations at this time.
